**The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2013 (as amended)
 Notification of grant of approval of an authorised treatment facility with the use of an agreed protocol**

The Environment Agency have considered your application for approval as an authorised treatment facility (AATF) under the Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2013 (as amended) with the use of a Site Specific Protocol and hereby grant approval to **Wiser Recycling Ltd** to operate as an AATF at the following sites only :

Your approval is subject to the conditions of approval specified in Part 2 of Schedule 11 to the Regulations at the approved sites listed above. A copy of these conditions is attached.

Your approval is valid from 1 January 2016 and ends on 31 December 2016, unless it is otherwise suspended or cancelled. The approval applies only to the named operator for the specified approved site. You must notify the Environment Agency immediately, in writing, of any changes to the details submitted with your application.

If you wish to apply the protocol to another site, you must submit an additional protocol application, providing evidence of sampling, which will be assessed by the Environment Agency to determine if the protocol can be applied to the additional site.

The acknowledgment of the protocol is subject to the conditions listed in Annex 1.

This approval applies only to the legal entity named in this letter. If this changes then your approval will be deemed to be cancelled and you must make a new application for approval. If you cease to be an authorised treatment facility your approval will also be deemed to be cancelled.

The approval allows you to issue evidence notes for waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) which you received at this site and which is subsequently re-used, treated, recovered or recycled.

If you issue evidence notes for greater than 400 tonnes of WEEE you must inform us immediately and you will be liable to pay the balance of the charge, namely £2070, from that date.

This approval does not replace any other environmental authorisation(s) that you may have for the sites. You must continue to comply with these and other relevant legislation.

AATFs wishing to be approved for the next compliance period (1 January – 31 December 2017) and to have their approval run continuously, should apply to the Environment Agency using the relevant application forms before 30 September 2016.

Sampling

The Environment Agency would expect there to be an annual sampling plan for your protocol application.

Your sampling needs to be representative of the WEEE that you are receiving.

If there are significant changes to the type or sources of the WEEE you receive you must ensure your protocol remains valid. If there's significant change during a year you must contact the Environment Agency to discuss whether additional sampling will be required for the current compliance year to maintain the protocol's validity.

Your use of this protocol will be inspected during site audits, to ensure that it is being applied appropriately and the data is being recorded is auditable and accurate.

Please note, the Environment Agency may ask you to increase the level of sampling if there are concerns with the protocol or any data discrepancies. The Environment Agency reserve the right to withdraw our acknowledgement of the protocol if information indicates it is providing inaccurate reporting of WEEE.
